The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Running-Marquardt, Vice Chairperson Rogers and Supervisor Zumbach. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Vice Chairperson Rogers called the meeting to order.

The Board heard updates from the following Department Heads:

Brad Ketels, County Engineer – KPI's; fall department meeting October 25th; office team attended the annual Iowa County Engineers Organization meeting in Des Moines; budget update; Secondary Roads Headquarters update; one vacant position; highlighted the construction projects that are wrapping up for the year; concrete bridge spraying is finishing up; winter season will be starting with more mix than they have used in the past 10 years.

Chairperson Running-Marquardt stated that she talked to Garret Reddish about the project near the Angle Inn and Fairfax and closing the road for two-hour windows and asked Ketels to clean up the language in the letter.
