

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2025 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Meisheid, Vice Chairperson Running-Marquardt and Supervisor Rogers. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Meisheid called the meeting to order.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Rogers to approve minutes of February 19, 2025 as presented.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Rogers to approve accounts payable checks dated 2/24/25 #71017070 to 71017071 in the amount of \$14,233.00 and voids totaling \$14,233.00 and claims dated 2/21/25 for payroll check #63000026 in the amt. of \$1,488.73 due to an ACH return.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Running-Marquardt to open a public hearing on proposal to rename Duck Pond Road between Game Club Road and Sawyer Road in Section 6, Township 85, Range 5 as Boy Scout Road.

There were no oral or written objections.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Rogers to close public hearing.

Luke Fischer, Facilities Dir., presented a quote between Linn County and D & N Fence Co., Inc. to supply and install exterior fencing at the Juvenile Detention Center for a combined total of \$33,895. The Board will approve on Wednesday.

Legislative Updates:

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin., made the Board aware of HSB187 re: immigration process. He and Supervisor Rogers spoke with Sheriff Gardner on the matter.

Supervisor Rogers stated that the Board has received several emails encouraging the Board to lobby against this bill. The Sheriff has indicated that he has manpower issues now with addressing the current workload. He will comply but what does that look like when they have a workforce that won't allow them to meet those standards. Rogers continued to say that this is another example of chipping away at local control. He has not responded to emails.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Rogers to approve payroll authorizations (detail is available upon request).
