

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
TUESDAY, MAY 27, 2025 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Meisheid, Vice Chairperson Running-Marquardt (via phone) and Supervisor Scheetz. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Meisheid called the meeting to order.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Scheetz to approve minutes of May 21, 2025 as printed.

Motion by Scheetz, seconded by Meisheid to approve claim dated 5/23/25 for payroll deduction checks #71017929 - #71017933 in the amount of \$13,353.74, ACH in the amount of \$62,105.31, an EFT wire in the amount of \$764,041.30 and a Ceridian ER Funds Trust Wire in the amount of \$2,233,075.15, for a total of \$3,072,575.50.

Curt Logan, Asst. County Engineer, presented a 28E Agreement between Benton County and Linn County for the Linn-Benton Road Construction Project for repair and overlay with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) on shared portions of Linn-Benton Road noting that this is adding to an existing project. The Board will approve Wednesday.

Logan also presented a 28E Agreement between the City of Marion and Linn County for a Maintenance Project for rock overlay with a double seal coat on 35th Ave from Highway 13 noting that everything will be paved. The Board will approve Wednesday.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin., presented a Resolution Establishing Provisions for the Permitting and Use of Fireworks. There was a change in state law regarding the date's fireworks can be regulated (adding July 3rd). This resolution will supersede the resolution that is currently in place.

Supervisor Meisheid added that this change is due to a change in the law and the resolution only affects those in unincorporated Linn County. If someone lives in a city there may be different rules to follow.

The Board will approve Wednesday.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Scheetz to enter into closed session to discuss pending litigation, pursuant to Code of Iowa 21.5(1)(c).
