

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
MONDAY, JUNE 23, 2025 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Meisheid, Vice Chairperson Running-Marquardt and Supervisor Scheetz. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Meisheid called the meeting to order.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Running-Marquardt to approve minutes of June 18, 2025 as presented.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to approve claim dated 6/20/25 for payroll deduction checks #71018192 - #71018196 in the amount of \$12,922.57, ACH in the amount of \$61,662.90, an EFT wire in the amount of \$781,799.11 and a Ceridian ER Funds Trust Wire in the amount of \$2,227,470.26, for a total of \$3,083,854.84.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Running-Marquardt to remove from the agenda the following as the public hearing notice was not published: Public hearing on an ordinance amending the code of Ordinances, Linn County, Iowa, by amending provisions in Chapter 105 Article III, pertaining to Electrical Installations and First Consideration of an ordinance amending the code of Ordinances, Linn County, Iowa, by amending provisions in Chapter 105 Article III, pertaining to Electrical Installations.

Richie Fox, Asst. Chief 3rd Fire Dist., presented a request from the Linn County 3rd Fire District to reallocate funds awarded through the fiscal year 2025 Witwer Trust Fund Grant process. He stated that it's been a difficult year and as a result, they cannot follow through with purchasing the Jaws of Life as was intended to do with the grant. However, they would like to reallocate those funds to purchase dated equipment that is needed.

Chairperson Meisheid stated that she spoke with the Fire Chief this morning and is supportive of this change in the grant. There is fundraising underway to fund the Jaws of Life, however, the grant has a deadline prior to achieving the fundraising goals for the Jaws of Life. She also thanked them for the transparency in the process and for coming back to the Board with this request.

Supervisor Running-Marquardt stated that she also supports the request and is appreciative of the Central City 3rd Fire Dist. and everything they do to keep Linn County residents safe.

The Board will approve on Wednesday.

Sara Bearrows, Budget Dir., presented a Resolution authorizing the transfer of \$50,000 from the Board of Supervisors Appropriations to the County Attorney Appropriations within the Linn County Fiscal Year 2025 Annual Budget.

Supervisor Running-Marquardt stated that she really appreciates all of the good work that Gayle Keiser and the County Attorney do to make the budget work. She noted that they have many variables in their department that a lot of other departments do not have to deal with.
