

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2025 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Meisheid, Vice Chairperson Running-Marquardt and Supervisor Scheetz. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Meisheid called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to approve accounts payable checks dated 8/6/25 #71018600 to 71018679 in the amount of \$201,146.61; and ACH in the amount of \$2,685,507.82; for a total of \$2,886,654.43 and to approve voids totaling \$440.00.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Running-Marquardt to approve Consent Agenda as follows:

Resolution 2025-8-121

A Resolution Setting a Public Hearing for Monday, August 25, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. to determine whether Linn County will vacate right-of-way along a portion of Scotland and Rowley Road located in section 22-85-06. A portion of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 22, T. 85N., R. 06W., more particularly described as follows: All that portion of Scotland and Rowley Road that lies along the south and east lines of said NW 1/4 NW 1/4 and lying 33' east of the current centerline of Scotland and Rowley Road. Said vacated area = 20,862 sf or 0.48 acres. more or less, subject to easements and restrictions of record or use

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign a Purchase of Service Agreement between Linn County and Area Substance Abuse Council for placement of Linn County residents in the amount of \$47.54 per day. Effective July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign a Linn County FY26 Provider and Program Participation Amendment for Substance Abuse Commitments between Linn County and Unity Point St. Lukes Hospital. The rates for service are \$794.90 per day for committal, not to exceed seven days and a two-day maximum for emergency order, \$198.81 for one-time admission, and \$180.08 for a one-time commitment hearing. Effective July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign a Linn County Children's Mental Health Assistance Program FY26 Provider Agreement between Linn County and Unity Point St. Lukes Hospital, the amount varies depending on the therapy services provided, from \$424.32 to \$65.49. Effective July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign a Linn County Children's Mental Health Assistance Program FY26 Provider Agreement between Linn County and Heart & Solutions LLC. The amount varies depending on services provided, from \$175.12 to \$25.84. Effective July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Approve the Settlement and Release Agreement between Linn County and Cristy Caldwell, individually and as Administrator of the Estate of Malorie Hults.

Supervisor Meisheid stated that she requested more time Monday to review this agreement. She has since met with legal to review and has no issues with it.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Running-Marquardt to approve a 28E agreement between Linn County and East Central Iowa Local Workforce Development Area regarding the shared liability of the member counties.

Mike Tertinger, Planning & Development, stated that this rezoning request was on Monday's agenda and no comments have been received.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Running-Marquardt to approve Second Consideration of a request to rezone 2.21 acres located at 3301 Lewis Bottoms Road, Palo, Iowa, from Renewable Energy Overlay in the Agricultural District (RE-AG) to Agricultural (AG).

Public Comment: Circe Stumbo, 3839 Cottage Grove Ave. SE, CR, stated that she went to the ICE Field Office for check-in's where 5 made it through and 3 others were detained. Stumbo explained the bill that passed last month regarding border enforcement. She referred to the war on crime in the 1980's and the trauma and damage of those that were wrongfully convicted. Stumbo is disappointed that Linn County has a contract with ICE and asked several questions regarding monitoring those ICE detainees in Linn County's jail.

Supervisor Meisheid stated that the first day of the Iowa State Fair is tomorrow and she encouraged others to attend.
