

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Running-Marquardt, Vice Chairperson Scheetz and Supervisor Meisheid. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Running-Marquardt called the meeting to order.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to approve minutes of March 9 and 10, 2026 as printed.

Motion by Scheetz, seconded by Meisheid to approve accounts payable checks dated 03/16/26 #71020759 to #71020762 in the amount of \$3,346.34, and voids totaling \$3,346.34.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Administration, discussed a proposal from Solum Lang Architects for Building Assessment and Schematic Design Services for the Linn County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) Facility storage buildings located off Highway 13, Marion, Iowa. This proposal would give a floor plan and estimate of probable cost. Duane Arnold has agreed to participate in this remodeling to an unspecified percentage at this point and request some sort of a plan in order to determine that participation. This proposal is for \$30,000 and the rest of the work is estimated at \$2 million, but can be done in phases.

Supervisor Running-Marquardt expressed appreciation to Gage, EMA, and the architects for their work in moving this process forward. A new set of decontamination showers is needed because of Duane Arnold so she appreciates them being a good partner. She is excited to see the new building move forward.

The Board will approve Wednesday.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to approve payroll authorizations (detail is available upon request).

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to appoint Diane Brecht to the Linn County Board of Adjustment to finish an unexpired term, ending December 31, 2029.
