

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Running-Marquardt, Vice Chairperson Scheetz and Supervisor Meisheid. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Running-Marquardt called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Scheetz, seconded by Running-Marquardt to approve accounts payable checks dated 05/06/26 #71021170 to #71021249 in the amount of \$296,168.98; and ACH in the amount of \$3,128,047.58; for a total of \$3,424,216.56 and voids totaling \$700.00.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to approve Consent Agenda as follows:

Receive and place on file the Auditor's Quarterly Report for the quarter ending March 31, 2026, in the amount of \$54,767.78.

Resolution 2026-5-67

A Resolution approving a Final Plat for MCGRAW FARM FIRST ADDITION.

The following description is a summary of Resolution 2026-5-67 as passed and approved by Linn County Board of Supervisors, effective May 6, 2026.

MCGRAW FARM FIRST ADDITION (Case # PF26-0005) to Linn County, Iowa, containing three (3) lots, numbered lots 1 and 2, and lettered lot A has been filed for approval, a subdivision of real estate located in the SE NW 28-86-08 of Section 28, Township 86 North, Range 8 West of the 5th P.M., Linn County, Iowa, described as follows:

Beginning at the Center of said Section 26;

thence N89°58'12"W along the south line of said SE ¼ NW¼, 655.54 feet to the SW Corner of the SE ¼ of the SE ¼ NW¼;

thence N00°43'22"W along the west line of said SE¼ of the SE ¼NW¼, 331.04 feet to the north line of said South ½ of the SE¼ of the SE¼ NW¼;

thence S89°56'02"E along said north line, 655.64 feet to the east line of said SE ¼ NW¼;

thence S00°42'20"E along said east line, 330.62 feet to the Point of Beginning containing 4.98 acres which includes 0.94 acres of road right of way.

Approve purchase order PO895 to Capital Sanitary Supply – Cedar Rapids in the amount of \$15,737.56 for a Tennant S680 Small Ride-On Floor Sweeper for the Secondary Road Headquarters.

Approve purchase order PO902 to Hupp Toyotalift Inc in the amount of \$16,800 for a Nilfisk SW3000 Large Ride-On Floor Sweeper for the Secondary Road Headquarters.

Approve purchase order PO904 to Coleman Moore Company for erosion control materials in the amount of \$50,820.95 for the Secondary Road Department.

Approve and authorize the Chairperson to sign Amendment No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 2026 Linn County Secondary Road Budget for submission to the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT).

Supervisor Meisheid read Proclamation: Building Safety Month, May 2026.

Motion by Meisheid, seconded by Scheetz to adopt said Proclamation.

Phil Foster, Guitars for Vets, gave a presentation to highlight services provided to Linn County veterans and discuss potential funding opportunities. This group started in 2007 to help those with PTSD and other service-related trauma and has over 150 nationwide chapters. 20 veterans have graduated from the local chapter which involves learning 7 chords and 4 songs during a 10-week program. They can then choose to continue with monthly jam sessions. There are currently 9 instructors and 9 students. They are looking for grant money to fund additional guitars to take on more students. Supervisor Running-Marquardt expressed her appreciation to Foster for appearing before the Board today and for his work on behalf of veterans across the state of Iowa.

Jessie Black, Admin. Specialist, suggested various grant programs available through the County, including the Economic and Community Development Fund and the Witwer Trust Fund. Black will include Foster in the informational emails when those grants open.

Motion by Running-Marquardt, seconded by Scheetz to remove from agenda: Discuss and decide on a Resolution Authorizing an Appropriations Transfer within the Linn County Fiscal Year 2026 Annual Budget of \$50,000 from the Board of Supervisors appropriations to Purchasing appropriations.
