Ciha read email from Grant Reddish – 2 federally funded projects in 2023. Concrete overlay on walkway & replacing bridge # 164. HPC agreed there is no action necessary



from Historical Preservation Commission for either project.

Budget

\$9420. Fall amendment, should get \$10,040. Possible 2023 funds, \$19,460. Committed \$2000 Lisbon & \$2000 to Mt Vernon for kiosks.

FY 2023 Work Plan

Ciha talked about Lincoln Heights area needing maintenance and design for handicapped accessibility. Engineering is following state law regarding that, so no design input from them. Perhaps obtain a civil engineer to design something? Lientz stated it is road right of way, so she will talk to Secondary Roads & Engineering to see if they would be able to take it out of road right of way, and then we could check with the Conservation Department if they would maintain it. Lientz will check to see if the bridge is National Registry eligible.

McNall asked if we have been asked for an interpretive kiosk for Indian Bridge. Pilcher stated that she has encouraged the Indian Creek Nature Center to apply for interpretive signage for Bertram Bridge when the move is complete.

Pilcher will be applying for the CLG grant for Klinsky Farms LTD. Lientz will forward Pilcher the Linn County login for the CLG account. Lientz will search for the CLG application for Coggon.

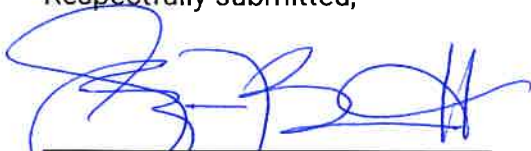
