FY 2022 Work Plan

This year's Rural Preservation Initiative will be the Klinsky Farm, at 1534 Ivanhoe Road. Pilcher will forward the paper written by the granddaughter to the rest of the Commission. Pilcher did apply for a CLG grant, with the goal of nominating the property for the National Historic Register.

While the County has implemented the new grant software, the Historic Preservation Commission's grant has not been added to that program.

The Commission will need someone to step into Amanda Happel's roles to coordinate the Lincoln Highway Kiosk repairs and upgrades.

McNall asked if we could invite people to apply for the Commission – he believes Tim Oberbrockling would make a good candidate.

There is a training opportunity for Commission members for the National Trust Preservation Conference. Copeland-Marvin, McNall & Pilcher are already signed up.

There was discussion about the old Bertram fire station on Mt Vernon Road. Peterson noted work is being done on the building. Lientz was looking into the Right of Way information.

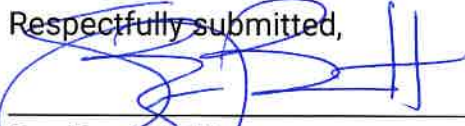

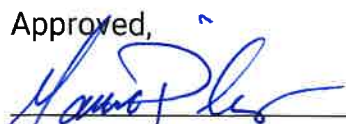
