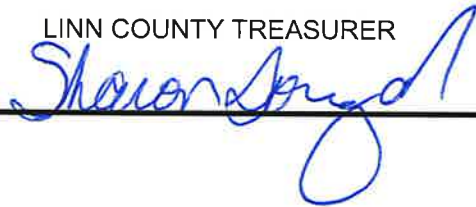

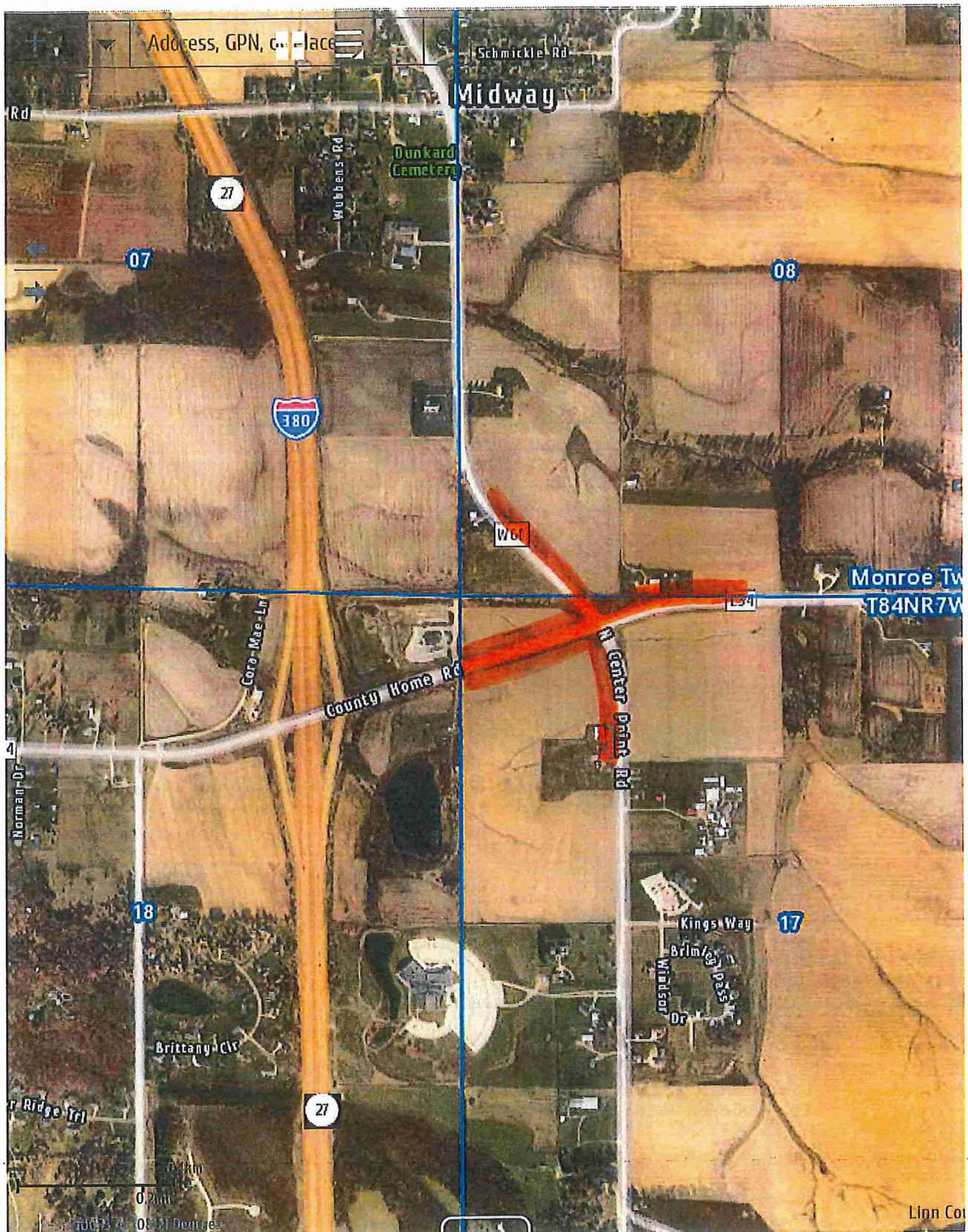

Most sites are not within direct visual observation via roadways accessible to law enforcement. Site security is maintained by a combination of gates and fenced compounds. In addition, sites have multiple IP based surveillance cameras that are monitored by each dispatch center. The camera system is a integrated part of the monitoring system as maintained by the current contracted vendor RACOM.

The server is outdated and needs replaced, so RACOM was the only qualified vendor due to their current contract for maintaining the county-wide radio system.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF LINN COUNTY, IOWA BY REZONING AND CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 3381 SCHMICKLE RD, IOWA FROM THE "AG" AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO THE "RR1" RURAL RESIDENTIAL 1-ACRE DISTRICT
