

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
 CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
 MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2023 10:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center. Present: Chairperson Zumbach and Vice Chairperson Rogers. Absent: Supervisor Running-Marquardt (personal business). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Zumbach called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Zumbach to approve claims for ACH dated 10/23/2023 in the amount of \$352.00; to approve payable voided checks in the amount of \$352.00; to approve claim dated 10/20/2023 for payroll EFT Wire in the amount of \$40.00 for a total of \$40.00.

Motion by Zumbach, seconded by Rogers to approve minutes of October 18, 2023 as printed.

Motion by Zumbach, seconded by Rogers to open public hearing to determine whether Linn County will vacate right-of-way along a portion of Section 35, T. 85N., R.08W. of the 5th P.M., Linn County, Iowa described as follows: Existing Feather Ridge Road right-of-way lying south of the south line of Moody's First Addition to Linn County as recorded in Bk. 3094, Pg. 524, Linn County Recorder's to the south line of said Section 35 being the north right-of-way line of Hagerman Road. Said vacated area = 1.69 acres more or less, subject to easements and restrictions of record or use.

Garret Reddish, Asst. County Engineer, stated that there are no land locked parcels with this vacation so no access issues or access easements are required. Linn County owns the right of away so no quit claim deed is needed. Proof of publication was presented. There were no oral or written objections.

Sheryl Schumacher, 3845 Hagerman Rd., Toddville, stated that their property butts up to this road which is a Class C and gated at both ends. They are in favor of the road vacation.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Zumbach to close public hearing.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin., presented Fiscal Year 2024 Legacy and Community Attraction Fund grant requests for discussion noting that in the past those with two votes or more move forward.

Supervisor Rogers thanked Jason Wright from the History Center who is in the audience for the great return of investment with his program. Rogers appreciates the opportunity to be partners.
